MEd in Special Education Behavior Specialist Concentration

This represents the collaborative, interdisciplinary program between Graduate Psychology and Exceptional Education. Students who are admitted to an approved special education program (M.Ed or MAT) have the option to also apply to complete the Behavior Specialist Concentration. This concentration is an approved course sequence from the Behavior Analyst Certification Board and prepares the student to qualify for the Board Certified Behavior Analyst Exam.

Admittance to one of the EXED M.Ed. or MAT programs alone does not guarantee admittance to the BCBA course sequence, which must be applied to separately. Students are admitted after completing an interview process.
