Parking Appeals Committee End of Year Report 2023-2024

Enclosed is the end-of-year report for the 2023-2024 Parking Appeals Committee. The committee met bi-monthly throughout the year, for a total of 18 meetings from August to May. Meetings were held in person in Taylor Hall, Room 303. From August to May, the committee reviewed 1320 appeals.

A predominate number of these appeals were overtime parking and restricted lot violations. There continues to be an issue with student attempting to stack payments at the pay-by-spaces. They do not seem to understand that pay-by-space are designated for short term parking. There continues to be an issue with student being confused as to when they are allowed to park in Faculty/Staff lots even though the information is cleared print on lot signage. There were also an unusual number of unregistered vehicle violations this year, especially at the start of spring semester. Many students that purchased a semester permit seemed to be unaware of the permit expiration date. Some students were under the impression that vehicles were not ticketed over the fall break, the holiday breaks, and spring break. Many others thought that you could park on campus after 4pm without a permit.

Virtual permits overall seem to have worked well. There were some duplicate use violations in the being of the year. Users with two people in the household working at JMU had the vehicles either listed on both users' permits or one user had two vehicles on one permit and had violations for two vehicles on campus at the same time. Once they were made aware of the changes they need to make on their virtual permits, these violations tapered off. In a few cases, a person with multiple vehicles on their permit would go home during their lunch break and bring the other back to campus and would receive duplicate use violation. In these cases, there was normally 1 ½ to 2-hour time lapse between the plates being scanned. This is an issued that need to be addressed by Parking Services.

It is always helpful for the committee to make decisions if all citations issued include photographs, rather than just certain citation types. For the most part photos were included, however there were some citations that would have been easier to adjudicate if we had had photos to back up our decision. The committee upheld some citations based on the information in the appeal, since photographs available in order to make a precise decision. It is helpful for the parking officers to include chalk mark information on the citation when violators are parking in place like the APC pull off where there is not a pay by plate option but there is a maximum time limit for parking in that space. In this instance, where there was not documentation show the time limit was exceeded and the appealer said they were not over time, the committee upheld the appeal.

Parking and Transit Service personnel were extremely helpful in obtaining additional information and clarifying parking violations questions. Olivia Fulk has been a great resource for us, as co-chairs. We are extremely grateful for their willingness to help us.

Three members of SGA were assigned to the Parking Appeals Committee this year. They give the committee incite on the student perspective. This was beneficial in helping the committee make decisions.
