Summary for 2023-2024:

Created three working groups: Standards; Facilities and Classrooms; Barrier Reporting and Response. Standards is creating a template that will consistently communicate information regarding accessibility standards. Facilities and Classrooms are making updates to JMU's accessibility map and are identifying and sectioning classrooms on campus for students that need accommodations. The Barrier Reporting Response analyzed the efficiency and effectiveness of our current JMU "Report A Barrier" form and are in the process of improving the form to encompass a wider range of barriers to include physical, digital, and programmatic. In addition, the group received a significant

number of recommendations from the SGA at the end of the semester regarding the JMU accessibility map. Much of the summer will be dedicated to reviewing and addressing many of these recommendations.

2024-2025 Meetings:

At least four committee meetings will be scheduled for the upcoming academic year, and we expect to have all new working groups in the 2024-2025 academic year.
