## Ropes Course

University Recreation is building a beautiful ropes course on approximately one wooded acre in the upper portion of University Park off of Neff Road. It consists of a tall ropes course and a low ropes course. The tall course is made up of three immense wooden towers that are connected by metal cables or "belays" that are approximately 36 feet high in the air. Participants will traverse the course using harnesses affixed to these cables. There will also be a zip line. The lower course consists of wooden structures, a foot or so off the ground, that can be traversed with the assistance of another person. The purpose of the configuration and construction of the lower course is to encourage teamwork.

Facilities Management Construction Engineer, Tim Shantz, has been working on the project for the last two years. It has been an exciting, but challenging project due to the specialized design process required of an atypical, nonbuilding, type of structure. Because of the complexities related to this type of project, the state's Bureau of Capital Outlay Management



(BCOM) is using the design process for JMU's rope course as a model for the state as a standard of how to approach planning and constructing this type of facility.

The ropes course is a part of UREC's Adventure Program and is planned to be used as an outreach for community organizations. JMU's faculty and staff will also have access to this area of University Park through group programs and academic coursework to enhance team and leadership development. Completion of the ropes course is expected in the next few weeks.
