Madison Hall is a newly renovated building that formerly housed the Rockingham Memorial Hospital Cancer Center. This \$25 million dollar project will yield an 81,000 square foot facility that will house the following departments: Admissions, Graduate Studies, Access and Inclusion, International Programs, and Physics. The Physics Department will be able to use the radiation lab inherited from the cancer center, including a linear accelerator and x -ray machinery in the original vault. The area surrounding the facility features an event lawn and a pedestrian colonnade. The building connects to the parking deck and Student Success center through a sky bridge. Move-in of various departments will begin the end of this month.
