

JMU FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION:

REIMBURSEMENT FOR JMU SGA STUDENT TRAVEL TO VHEAD (VIRGINIA HIGHER EDUCATION ADVOCACY DAY) ON JANUARY 12, 2017

Whereas:

- Civic engagement is a key commitment of James Madison University, and a worthy goal in its own right;
- 8 members of the JMU SGA traveled to Richmond on January 12, 2017 to take part in Virginia Higher Education Advocacy Day (by petitioning legislators to stop reducing state support for higher education); and
- It is valuable and worthwhile for the Faculty Senate to support the civic engagement efforts of its students,

Be it now resolved that:

The Faculty Senate of JMU will reimburse the travel costs of the JMU student delegation to VHEAD (a total cost of \$36.79¹) from the Faculty Senate Treasury.

[NOTE: According to our Bylaws (Article VI), resolutions that involve the use of Faculty Senate Treasury funds must pass by a 2/3 majority (of those present and voting)]
