

Whereas the Senate has struggled for more than a decade to keep its website updated, and

Whereas it is very important for the website to be updated consistently and soon following Senate meetings and other actions, and

Whereas updating the website requires technical skills that elected officers typically do not have, and

Whereas a Senate webmaster could acquire the necessary skills and use them year after year to keep the Senate website updated, and

Whereas this service should be acknowledged by giving the webmaster a formal office and title,

Be it therefore resolved that Senate Bylaws, Article III: Officers, be modified as follows:

F. Webmaster

1. The webmaster is appointed to an indefinite term and, while willing to continue in office, serves at the pleasure of the Senate Steering Committee.
2. The webmaster is an *ex officio*, non-voting member of the Senate Steering Committee and of the Faculty Senate. The webmaster may attend, but is not required to attend meetings of the Senate Steering Committee and the Faculty Senate.
3. As instructed by the Senate Steering Committee, the webmaster provides timely updates of the Senate webpage and helps manage technical aspects of the Senate Canvas website.
