**Interfaith Peace Camp** is a week-long day camp for children **8-12 years** old interested in **building friendships and understanding** with children from other local **faith traditions**.

When we build relationships with others, it is less likely that we will wish them harm. The camp creates opportunities and tools for peace-building, helping campers explore similarities and honor differences. The camp is planned and staffed by an interfaith, intergenerational team of community members.



## Junior Counselor Program

Interfaith Peace Camp also offers a **Junior Counselor Program** for 13-18 year old youth. Junior Counselors help oversee small groups of campers, assist teachers, and help with art/recreation/music activities. Meet new friends and be a positive role model for younger campers!
