Qualifications

Applicants must:

- Be a current student at James Madison University
- Have completed a study abroad program (JMU, Exchange, or External) before taking a position
- Have a strong passion for Study Abroad and for International Education
- · Have leadership experience and/or a sincere interest in developing these skills
- Be reliable, responsible, and able to devote the necessary time to the position
- · Be able to represent the office in a professional manner at all times
- · Possess strong communication and presentation skills

Global Ambassador Responsibilities

Global Ambassadors will be expected to:

- Help coordinate, prepare for, and staff many of our Study Abroad events, both large and small. These events include, but are not limited to, International Week (September), Study Abroad Week (February), CHOICES, Admissions Open Houses, Pre- Departure Orientations, info sessions and returnee events.
- Assist with advertising and promoting events, creating banners, giving in-class presentations, coordinating outreach activities with other offices on campus, and creating partnerships throughout the JMU community.
- Attend Global Ambassador meetings every other week.
- Assist study abroad recruitment efforts such as tabling on campus, presentations, and events.
- Work approximately 42 hours per semester, compensated with a \$504 stipend each semester.

*Note: As part of the Global Ambassador position, you will be required to attend a mandatory two-day Study Abroad Global Ambassador Orientation, scheduled 9am-3pm on August 21st and 22nd.

In addition to these responsibilities, Global Ambassadors will be selected to fill <u>one</u> of the following coordinator roles. We aim to have two coordinators in each role:

1. Peer Advisor Coordinator(s)

- Primarily responsible for peer advising, tabling, presentations, etc. and coordinating extra coverage and support when needed from other Global Ambassadors.
- Responsible for co-chairing the Global Duke Peer Advisor Committee.

2. Marketing & Design Coordinator(s)

- Primarily responsible for social media marketing and design projects with the goal of advertising study abroad opportunities.
- Responsible for co-chairing the Global Duke Marketing and Design Committee.

* Previous art or graphic design experience (Adobe Creative Suite, Canva, etc.) is preferred. Please include 3-4 samples of previous work in your application.

3. Returnee & Stewardship Coordinators(s)

- Primarily responsible for overseeing and the recruitment of Global Dukes, coordinating events for SA returnees, and working to connect with JMU alumni who studied abroad.
- Be responsible for coordinating monthly Global Dukes meetings.
- Responsible for co-chairing the Global Duke Returnee & Stewardship Committee.

Global Duke Responsibilities

Global Dukes will be expected to:

- Help coordinate, prepare for, and volunteer for many of our Study Abroad events such as International Week, The Study Abroad Fair, Taste of Study Abroad, Choices, Pre-Departure Orientations, Info Sessions, and tabling on campus.
- Complete 5 volunteer hours each semester. Hours can be gained by volunteering at study abroad events, peer advising, giving in class presentations and completing other outreach activities.
- Attend monthly Global Ambassador meetings.
