Minimum GPA requirement,	Flinders University equivalent 4.0 (pass) out of 7.0 scale after completing one academic year (2 semesters) of full-time study.	
English language requirements	If your first language is not English international students must satisfy our English language proficiency requirements for admission. Please read here for further information.	
Tuition Fee	You will pay tuition fees to your home university.	AUD\$10,000 for 3 topics (13.5 units) or 4 topics (18 units) includes 1 tour* The study abroad fee covers tuition, administrative costs, one academic transcript on completion and laboratory fees. <i>*Students commencing in S1 & S2 2023 only</i>
OSHC Fee (compulsory)	OSHC (Overseas Student Health Cover) can be different each year.	

Application Process

Semester Exchange through your Home Institution (1-2 semesters)	
1. Get nominated	Follow internal application procedures and get nominated to apply for Flinders by your home institution.
2. Apply	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Apply online to Flinders with necessary documents. Those nominated by their home institution will receive how to apply information from Flinders directly.
3. Receive an offer	Receive an offer letter if successful.
4. Accept an offer and Pay OSHC payment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete and return an acceptance and other necessary documents. Purchase an OSHC (Overseas Student Health Cover) through Flinders or by yourself.
5. Receive an eCoE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Receive an eCoE (Confirmation of Enrolment) letter and apply for a student visa
6. Send topic preference	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide a list of topics you would like to undertake at Flinders (7-8 topic preferences).
7. Enrol in topics and build a class timetable	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Receive topic assessment outcome. Enrol in pre-approved topics online and build a class timetable.

Study Abroad Program (1-2 semesters)	
1. Apply	<p><i>Apply via:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your home institution if you are nominated as a fee-paying study abroad student Educational agent Apply directly to Flinders <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Apply online to Flinders with necessary documents. Those nominated by their home institution will receive how to apply information from Flinders directly.
2. Receive an offer	Receive an offer letter if successful.
3. Accept an offer and pay a tuition fee & OSHC payment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Complete and return an acceptance and other necessary documents. Pay a tuition fee and purchase an OSHC (Overseas Student Health Cover) through Flinders or by yourself.
4. Receive an eCoE and apply for a student visa	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Receive an eCoE (Confirmation of Enrolment) letter and apply for a student visa
5. Request topics you would like to undertake	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide a list of topics you would like to undertake at Flinders (7-8 topic preferences).
6. Enrol in pre-approved topics and build a class timetable	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Receive topic assessment outcome. Enrol in pre-approved topics online and build a class timetable.

Supporting Documents for Online Application

- *Certified** copy of academic transcript in English demonstrating completion of at least one academic year/2 semesters).
- *Certified** copies of English language test results
- Passport information page (includes photo)
- 500-word student statement of purpose (not required for study abroad fee-paying applicants).

**Documents can be certified by the international office or delegate at home institution or education agent. Verifier should provide their full name, signature and date of signing.*

Application period	Semester 2 2023 (July) 27 March-30 April 2023	Semester 1 2024 (February) 18 September- 20 October 2023

Recommended arrival dates	1-2 weeks prior to commencement of teaching week 1 or follow the Flinders Living moving in date.	
Orientation dates	Typically, 1 week prior to the commencement of teaching week 1. It is compulsory to attend a welcome session for incoming exchange/study abroad students.

Restricted study area	Medicine, nursing, midwifery, and drama topics requiring audition are not open to exchange/study abroad students.
Full time study load per semester	International students are required to study full time (13.5-18 units per semester). Most Flinders topics are worth 4.5 units.
