Average Course

UNPAR students typically take **15-24 credits per semester**. Each credit corresponds to **50 minutes of class time and 100 minutes of assignments/self study** with a total of **14 class meetings**, one **Mid-term Exam**, and one **Final Exam** per course. In addition, students are required to maintain a **minimum of 80% attendance** in each class.

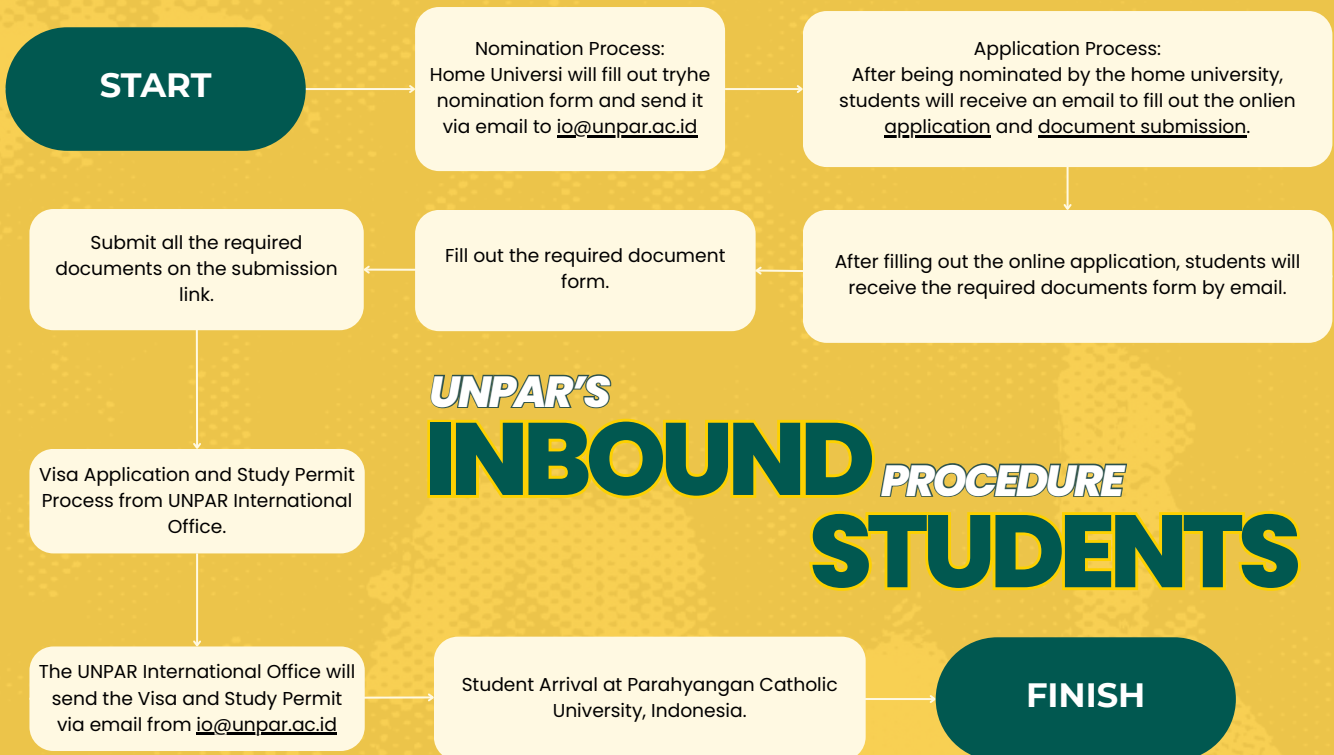

The Required Documents Needs to be filled out and signed, submit on PDF Files:

- Application Form (Form 1)
- Declaration Not to Work and to Obey Indonesian Law (Form 2 and Form 3)
- Recommendation Letter (Form 4)
- Letter of Fund Guarantee (Form 5)
- Proof of Good Health (Form 6)
- Study Plan (Form 7)
- Visa Application Statement Letter (Form)

Other required documents:

1. Official Academic Transcript
2. Last Education Certificate (Highschool/Diploma)
3. Valid passport at least 6 months beyond the end of the academic semester (please follow the example)
4. Formal ID Photo (please follow the example)
5. Proof of English Proficiency (TOEFL: 550 / IELTS: 6 / Other Equivalent Test)
6. Curriculum Vitae (CV) -> you can use your own template
7. Bank statement showing a minimum of US\$ 2,000 or equivalent for the past 3 months
