### Cost & Expenses

- ▶ Your specific and detailed bill will only be accessible in → [Madison Money Manager \(or M3\)](#), once and only once you will have completed all of the One Book steps. To access it, go to → [MyMadison](#).
- ▶ A preliminary breakdown of JMU tuition charges can be found on the → [Business Office's website](#). When you are calculating the cost of your bill, keep in mind that there will be additional fees beyond the cost of (out of state) tuition:
  - ▶ *The International Student Administration Fee*- a \$100 per semester (for F-1 and J-1 visa holders).
  - ▶ *A Health Insurance Fee*
  - ▶ *Books and school supplies*
  - ▶ *Other personal expenses*- may include: housing, food, clothing, travel during breaks, etc.

### Bank Account

- ▶ Because having a bank account in the U.S. will facilitate the transfer of funds, we will arrange for you to set-up a Free Checking Account at → [Atlantic Union Bank](#). There are no balance fees, no maintenance fees and more importantly any one can open an account without a social security number. The local bank located on campus does not allow individuals who do not have social security number to open a bank account.
