



Fees & Paying JMU

How will I have to pay JMU?

When calculating the cost of your bill, there will be additional fees with the out of state to the out of state tuition charges:

- The International Student Administration Fee: a \$100 per semester
- Health Insurance Fee: approximately \$650 per semester
- Books and school supplies
- Monthly rent & utilities: \$450+
- Additional departmental fees
- Other personal expenses include: food, clothing, etc.
- If you stay in the US over the summer, you can expect to spend an additional \$1,800.

How will I be paying my bills?

- All of your fees, tuition, room and board will be accessible via → [Money Manager](#) or M3
- Students are the only ones who have viewing and paying rights. If you would like to give your family member(s) either viewing and/or paying rights, you will need to give them the appropriate access
