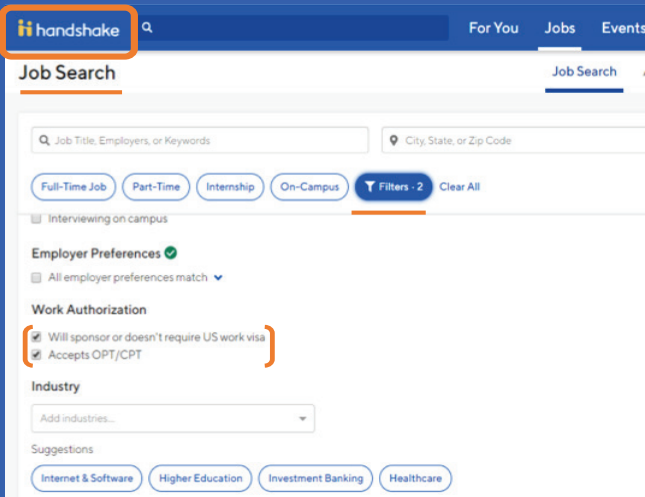


Resources to Simplify International Students' Search for Jobs & Internships
