

Immunization form

- ▶ The state of Virginia requires that every individual who is studying in the state receive all of the required vaccinations.
- ▶ Every JMU student must complete this [☺ immunization form](#) before the first days of class.
- Complete your vaccinations back home. The corresponding [☺ translated version](#) of the immunization form may come in handy as your health practitioner or doctor will need to sign the form.
- Once the form is completed and signed save the document as a pdf file and upload [☺ MYJMUChart](#).

Covid-19 immunization Requirement

- ▶ JMU is requiring every student to provide verification (by uploading it in [☺ MyJMUChart](#)) that they have been fully vaccinated for COVID-19 before returning to campus for Fall 2021.
- ▶ To check whether the vaccination you received is approved by JMU/US, refer yourself to this [☺ World Health Organization's list](#)
- ▶ In case you cannot get vaccinated before you arrive on campus, complete the [☺ Assumption of Risk form](#).
- ▶ Once you are on campus or in Harrisonburg you will be able to get vaccinated. At this point in time, it is too early to tell when and where you will be able to get vaccinated. The ISSS office, the Orientation office and The Student Health Center are working on providing you updates.

Health insurance

- ▶ By virtue of being on a (F-1 & J1) student visa, you must be insured.
- ▶ Our office works in conjunction with CISI- Cultural Insurance Services International health insurance company to ensure that you are insured with their plan. [☺ Health Insurance](#)
- If you currently hold an insurance policy that provides equal levels of coverage and lasts for the entire academic year*, you may qualify to waive out of the JMU-sponsored health insurance plan through CISI.
