<b>Diversity or Global Engagement Course (DIV) *</b> Select from pre-approved catalog list of courses that consider diverse perspectives, experiences, and cultures, OR look for a suitable course in Gen Ed or your major/minor. Does not need to be an Honors course.	3	
<b>Research or Experiential Learning Course(EXP) *</b> Select from pre-approved catalog list of courses, which include the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Research</li> <li>Internships</li> <li>Study abroad</li> <li>Creative work</li> <li>Clinical practice</li> <li>Field work</li> <li>Practica</li> <li>ePortfolios</li> <li>Research/teaching assistantship</li> <li>Community engagement</li> </ul> 1- and 2- credit courses may be combined. Look for opportunities in your major. Does not need to be an Honors course.	3

<b>Senior ePortfolio Project (completed through the Honors College)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>HON 401 (fall semester only)</li> <li>HON 402 (spring semester only)</li> <li>Any additional 3 credits of Honors-approved coursework</li> </ul> Students completing the Senior Portfolio Project will earn a graduation designation of <i>Honors Scholar</i> .	6	
<b>Departmental Honors Capstone Project (completed in academic dept.)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Departmental 499 sequence (A/B/C) or other department-established sequence</li> </ul> Capstone requirements are defined by the academic unit in consultation with the Honors College, and may result in (but are not limited to) a thesis, creative project, or portfolio.           Students completing the Departmental Honors Capstone Project will earn a graduation designation of <i>Honors Scholar with Distinction in [Major or Minor]</i> .	6
