Submission Requirements


- Text-based submissions should be between 2,000 and 6,000 words and accessible to a diverse academic audience.
- Digital- and media-based submissions can stand alone or can be supplemented by a brief research statement.
- You can submit up to one year after graduating.

Submission Process

- We accept and publish on a rolling basis.
- The editorial board screens all submissions.
- Faculty volunteers review the screened submissions with a discipline-specific eye.
- If accepted by the faculty readers, the submissions undergo copyediting and move towards publication.
