- JMU is a Silver Level Bicycle Friendly University
- Over 600 bike racks on campus
 - All parking decks have indoor, covered bike racks
- Lock your bike or scooter with a U-Lock
 - Cable locks are not recommended
- Obey all traffic laws
- Register your bike for FREE. All bikes and scooters should be registered.

INNER CAMPUS SHUTTLE

- Continuous loop around campus
- Every day that JMU is in session
- 7am-7pm, arrives every 5 minutes
- 7-11pm, arrives every 30 minutes

GREEN LINE

- Campus to off-campus apartment complexes
- 15-minute loop

SHOPPER

- Campus to local stores like Target, Walmart, & Valley Mall
- Monday-Saturday
- Hourly, 1-10pm

Regional and Break Travel

- Purchase a ticket. Bus stop is behind the bookstore.
- The Virginia Breeze stops on campus three times a day, everyday
 - Two routes go from SW Virginia (stops at VT), JMU, to Dulles Airport and Amtrak in DC
 - Goes to Virginia Beach once per day (stops along the way)
- Other coach bus services are Adventures-N-Travel, College Transit and OurBus
- The Brite Bus goes to BRCC and Staunton with connections to Waynesboro and Charlottesville
- Shenandoah Valley Regional Airport (SHD) flies direct to Chicago and Charlotte daily



Dukes Ride

For Transfer & Off-Campus Students

- Most off-campus apartment complexes have at least one bus route
- Ride the fare-free bus most of the time, buy a \$5/day parking pass as needed.
- Annual parking passes are \$300.

Parking

- Permits go on sale in mid-July and can be purchased through the web portal (jmu.aimsparking.com)
- Parking regulations should be followed at all times and enforcement is 24/7/365.
- Campus visitors must register for a free guest permit from the Parking and Transit office during weekdays. On weekends, visitors may park in general spaces without a permit.
