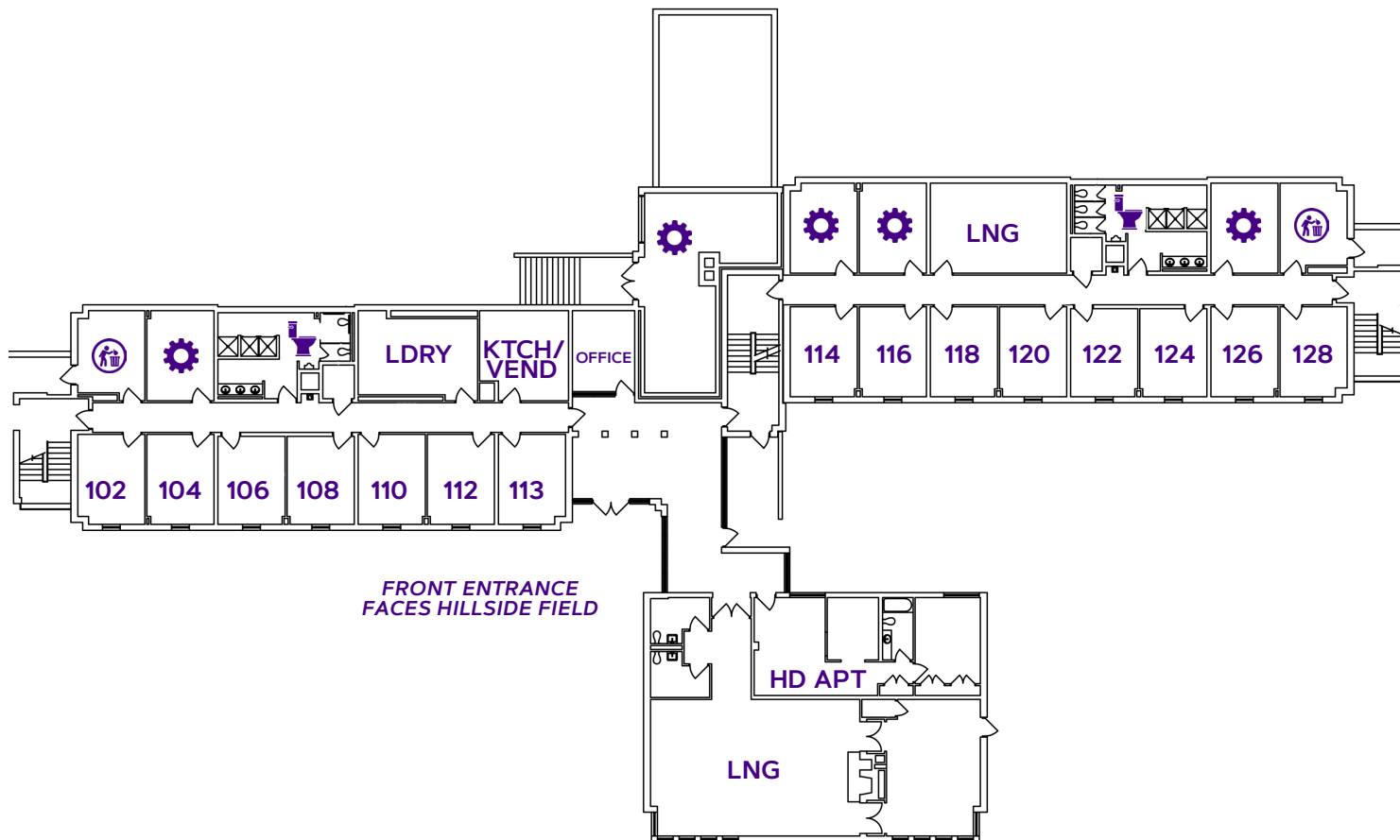

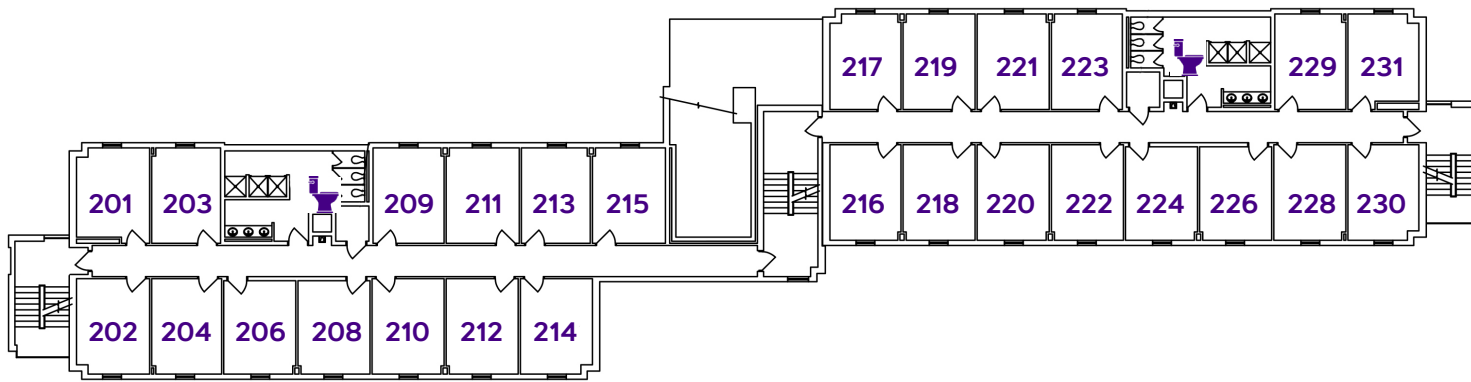

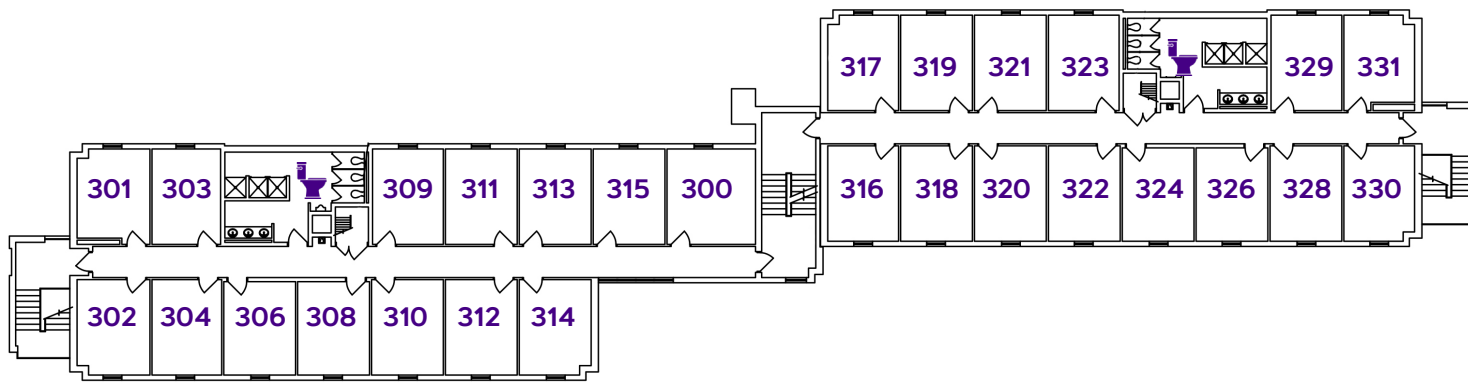

ACCESSIBLE DESCRIPTION OF FLOOR PLAN

COMPLETED: 1982

CAPACITY: 131 residents

This is a long rectangular building with three floors. There are four entrances to the first floor. Two of these are side entrances at the exterior stairwells; they face Hillside Hall and McGraw-Long Hall and lead into A and B sections respectively. The third entrance is behind the lounge facing McGraw-Long Hall. This entrance leads into a hallway with the lounge on the left and the lobby to the right. The main entrance faces Hillside field. This entrance leads into the lobby with the hall office in front of you. To the left is a hallway of bedrooms; this is A section. On the right of this hallway is the laundry room, kitchen, community bathroom, housekeeping closet, and the trash room. At the end of the hallway is a door leading to the outdoor stairwell. To the right of the lobby is a stairwell; this stairwell also leads to the B section hallway by going up one flight of stairs and through the door on the right. Down this hallway are bedrooms. On the left of the hallway is also a study room, community bathroom, housekeeping closet, and trash room. At the end of the hallway is a door that leads to the outdoor stairwell. To the right of the stairwell in the lobby is a hallway that leads to the lounge. In this hallway, on the right, there are two individual public bathrooms.

The second and third floors are set up the same way. There are two sections, A and B sections, separated by a stairwell. At the other end of each section is a door that leads to the outdoor stairwell. Each section has a community bathroom and housekeeping closet.
