Beginning with Fall 2022 mandated reporting, SCHEV has updated gender reporting policies to include "other/another" and "unknown/unreported". JMU will begin reporting the following values in all official data:

- "Men" or "Women": Students who self-identify as having a single binary gender identity.
- "Other/Another": Students who self-identify as having a gender identity that does not fall into either of the mutually exclusive binary categories provided (i.e., men or women). Includes students who identify as nonbinary and transgender.
- "Unknown/Unreported": Students who do not self-report a gender (i.e., missing data or does not know a gender).
