AS OF WEDNESDAY 3/24/2021 (A.M.), NUMBER OF EDUCATION RELATED BILLS:

- Introduced = 77 (45 D / 32 R)
- In Committee = 1
- Floor Consideration = 5
- Passed One Chamber = 5

- State authorization requirements (§600.9)
- Professional licensure program disclosures (§668.43)

July 1, 2021: Revisions to 34 C.F.R. Parts 600, 602, and 668 including:

- New terminology "academic engagement" (§600.2)

- Professional Licensure Disclosure Requirements

If an educational program is <u>designed to meet or is advertised as meeting</u> the educational requirements for a licensure or certification that is required for employment, then certain disclosures are required.



Professional Licensure Disclosure Requirements

Educational Requirements of the State vs. Education Provided by Your Program

- General disclosures for each program [34 CFR 668.43(a)(5)(v)]
 Meets, *Does Not Meet,* *Has not made determination*
 For each program, publish list of states falling into each category
- 2. Individualized Disclosure [34 CFR 668.43(c)]

<u>Does Not Meet</u>: must notify *current and prospective* students <u>Have Not Determined</u>: must notify *prospective* students

UPCOMING CHANGES TO THE HIGHER EDUCATION ACT

Becoming Effective July 1, 2021:

- Definitions of "clock hour," "credit hour" to address distance education
- Accountability for Distance Education: "Regular and substantive interaction"
- Definitions of "academic engagement" and "Week of instructional time"
 - now addressing distance education
- Regulations governing direct assessment programs (§668.10)
- Treatment of title IV funds when student withdraws a LOT of new language
