

# 2016 FAMILY WEEKEND PARKING / SHUTTLE INFO

## PARKING ON CAMPUS

On Friday through Sunday, September 30 – October 2, family members visiting the JMU campus to attend Family Weekend activities may park in standard, unmarked spaces in student lots (lots beginning with “C” or “R”) without the need for a permit, with the exception of lots reserved for football game day parking. Parents are recommended to consult the campus parking map at <http://www.jmu.edu/parking/files/parkingmap.pdf> to locate available parking lots.

Beginning at 5:00 PM on Friday, many campus lots will be reserved for football season parking permit holders. Affected lots near student residence halls include, but are not limited to G, P, C4, R1 and R8 Lots, and the Champions Drive Parking Deck. Refer to posted signage for additional information. All parking lots not reserved for season permit holders on game day are general parking, and visiting family members can park in these lots without a permit. Parking is available in general lots on a first-come, first served basis. A limited number of parking spaces in R1 Lot may be available for purchase on the day of the game at a cost of \$10 per space. ## SHUTTLE BUS SERVICES

Shuttle buses will operate continuously both on and off campus, beginning three hours prior to the football game until two hours after the game ends.

On campus, JMU buses will circulate from the parking lots at Convo, Festival (C11/C12 Lots), D2 Lot and the Godwin Transit Center (GTC) by the stadium. Buses will also circulate between the Warsaw parking deck and the GTC.

Off campus, Harrisonburg Transit buses will operate between virtually all of the City hotels, and the off-campus apartments to the GTC. These schedules are available at [www.hdpt.com](http://www.hdpt.com).

Shuttle bus services will also be provided for handicapped visitors. These buses will operate from the handicapped parking lot (R8 Lot) near the MLK Parkway to the Gate A and Gates C/D at the stadium. In addition, paratransit buses will be available on demand at any time throughout the campus and the City by calling HDPT at 540-432-0492
