Transfer and Change of Major students will need to adjust the sequence to match the curriculum and classes they have received credit for before entering the program. Completing the curriculum in 4 years for transfer and Change of Major students might not be possible.

Review the prerequisites for all ARCD Design course to better understand the degree sequence.

NOTE: ARCD studio courses are sequential and cannot be taken out of order. They are generally offered only once per academic year.

The Architectural Design recommended sequence adds up to the minimum load to reach 120 credits required for graduation. Each student's path will be different.

This is a 4 year path from 1st year to fourth year and does not take into consideration any courses taken during summer or other terms.

Students planning on pursuing the Master of Architecture degree (at another institution) will want to take PHYS 140 and MATH 205. These are also prerequisites for our ARCD 492 Structures elective.
