**SGA Grants Funds:** student fees originally, first got to F.E.B groups, leftovers go to us to give out **F.E.B.:** Front End Budgeted Groups (paid by JMU upfront) - 8 currently, potentially another coming soon? **Contingency Fund Request:** assist with event, equipment purchase or other valid expenditure.

• Yes - request follows procedures, is clear, all funding should be exhausted & fundraising should be done, clear positive impact for JMU students

**Program Grant:** funds events that organizations put on

• Yes - follows financial procedures, allowed to produce profit, has a clear impact on the student body

IDSA Contingency Fund Request: \$2,900 - Product Photography workshop

- Dues: \$20; members: 48 and growing; focus: professional development, portfolio reviews, alumni events
- Product Photography Workshop: students learning how to properly photograph their work, and students will have access to the camera afterwards supervised
  - Students actually create the products that they are putting in their portfolio, and without proper photography of their work they don't have as much access to jobs

- Funding Breakdown:
  - Camera (one of the nicest camera): \$2,200; external flash, lens, backdrop, tripod \$700
- Ai Vy's Question: are events for members only, or are they for the student body?

- Marcus' Question: will everyone have access afterwards or just Club members
  - Locked space for the camera is available, and someone will likely be in charge of it, so other people can use it they'll just have to connect with the club
