Advising Notes for Health Services Administration

1. Health Services Administration (HSA) is not an open major. Students must complete the following 4 prerequisite courses and achieve a grade of C- or higher to be fully admitted to the HSA program (BRCC equivalents in parentheses).
 - ECON 201, Microeconomics (ECO 202)
 - CIS 204, CIS Fundamentals for Non-Business Majors (ITE 120)
 - ACTG 244, Accounting for Non-Business Majors (see note #2 below)
 - HTH 354, U.S. and Global Health Care Systems (no equivalent, must be taken at JMU)Transfer students may apply to the major in their first semester at JMU if they have equivalent transfer credit for and/or enroll in the prerequisite courses in the first semester.
2. There is no equivalent for ACTG 244 at BRCC, but students may take **both** ACC 211 **and** 212 as two of their approved electives, and that will waive ACTG 244 at JMU.
3. Students also earn a minor in General Business as part of the HSA major.
4. See options for [history electives](#), [humanities/art/literature electives](#) (must take two courses from two different groups), [natural science electives](#), [general education electives](#), and [transfer core electives](#).
5. **Differential tuition for College of Business majors/minors:** Students will be charged an additional \$50 per credit for all College of Business courses taken at JMU. See [Differential Tuition](#) for more information.
