Advising Notes for Hospitality Management

- 1. Sport and Recreation Management is a Bachelor of Science degree; two math courses are required.
- 2. SRM majors also earn a minor in General Business. ITE 120 and ECO 202 satisfy minor requirements. ACC 244, Accounting for Non-Business Majors, is also required for the minor; there is not an equivalent at BRCC, but students may take **both** ACC 211 and ACC 212 and that will waive ACTG 244.
- 3. View options for <u>history electives</u>, <u>natural science electives</u>, <u>humanities/art/literature electives</u> (must take two courses from two different groups), <u>math electives</u>, and <u>transfer core electives</u>.
