Advising Notes for Hospitality Management

1. Sport and Recreation Management is a Bachelor of Science degree; two math courses are required.
2. SRM majors also earn a minor in General Business. ITE 120 and ECO 202 satisfy minor requirements. ACC 244, Accounting for Non-Business Majors, is also required for the minor; there is not an equivalent at BRCC, but students may take **both** ACC 211 and ACC 212 and that will waive ACTG 244.
