## **Anthropology Minor Requirements (18 credit hours)**

ANTH 195, ANTH 196, ANTH 197, and **three** Anthropology electives. Students must receive at least a C- to have a course count toward the minor.

## **Historical Archaeology Minor Requirements (22 credit hours)**

ANTH/HIST 331, ANTH 494, HIST/ARTH 396, ANTH/HIST 496, and **three** of the following (one from history/anthropology and one from geology options required): ANTH 410, ANTH 455, HIST/ARTH 394, HIST/ANTH/ARTH 492, HIST/ARTH 493, GEOL 430, GEOL 442. Two courses (6 credit hours) may be double-counted between the minor and the student's major.
