From the JMU Undergraduate Catalog: Every department and school at JMU offers a course designed to give capable students an opportunity to do faculty-supervised independent studies. In addition, these independent study courses allow especially capable students to work at their own, often accelerated pace. Arrangements for independent study should be made with individual faculty members.

Return the form to the Director of the department for review. Applications should be made before the beginning of the semester the course will be scheduled.
